# **MATERIALS:**



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Quilt: 78" x 78"

Blocks: 6" & 12"

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#### **PROJECT NOTES:**

- Wof = width of fabric
- Use ¼" seam allowance and press as desired.
- Materials and cutting list assumes 42" of usable fabric width.

# Block 1



CUT:

Black 3 @ 4 1/4" x wof, subcut:

25 @ 4 1/4" x 4 1/4"

White 3 @ 4 1/4" x wof, subcut:

25 @ 4 1/4" x 4 1/4"

**Grey** 5 @ 3 %" x wof, subcut:

50 @ 3 %" x 3 %"

#### SEW:

 Cut the grey squares in half diagonally once.






2. Cut the white and black squares in half diagonally twice.





- 3. Sew each white triangle to the left side of a black triangle. Make 100.
- 4. Sew a grey triangle to each for a 3 ½" unit.
- 5. Sew 4 units together with the white in the middle creating a pinwheel for a 6 ½" block 1. Make 25.



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#### Block 2



CUT:

Black

4 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut: 16 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" 3 @ 6 7/8" x 6 7/8"

1 @ 6 %" x wof, subcut: 5 @ 6 %" x 6 %"


14 @ 3 ½" x wof, subcut: 80 @ 3 ½" x 6 ½"

#### Light pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut: 3 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"

**Light Orange** 1 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut: 4 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"


- 6. Cut the black 6 %" squares in half diagonally once.
- 7. Cut all the 7 1/4" squares in half diagonally twice.
- 8. Sew a color triangle to the right side of a black triangle. Make 12 in each color except for orange, make 16 of those. See diagrams.



- 9. Sew a black 6 %" triangle to 3 pink, 4 blue, 4 green, 2 purple and 3 orange pieced triangles for 6 ½" units. See below.
- 10. Sew 2 black 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides of the step 9 units. These are the side units. 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ "



11. Sew the remaining triangles pairs together for 6 ½" units. See below for color combinations and amounts.



12. Sew 2 black 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the black sides of the step 11 units. 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ "



### Block 3



CUT:

Black 4 @ 3 %" x wof, subcut: 32 @ 3 %" x 3 %"

Dark pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ 4 1/4" x wof, subcut: 9 @ 4 1/4" x 4 1/4"

Medium pink, blue, green & purple, from

each: 1 @ 4 ½" x wof, subcut: 9 @ 4 ½" x 4 ½"

1 @ 3  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut: 6 @ 3  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3  $\frac{7}{8}$ "

Light pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ 3 %" x wof, subcut: 6 @ 3 %" x 3 %"

Lightest pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

2 @ 3 %" x wof, subcut: 12 @ 3 %" x 3 %"

**Dark orange** 2 @ 4  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut: 12 @ 4  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{4}$ "

**Medium orange** 2 @  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:  $12 @ 4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ "  $8 @ 3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

**Light orange** 1 @ 3%" x wof, subcut: 8 @ 3%" x 3%"

Lightest orange

2 @ 3 %" x wof, subcut: 16 @ 3 %" x 3 %"

- 13. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the medium colors 3 %" squares.
- 14. Pair the medium color and black 3 %" squares, right sides together, and sew ¼" on each side of the line. Cut on the line for 3 ½" HSTs (half square triangles). Make 12 in each color except orange, make 16 of those.







- 15. Cut the 4 1/4" squares in half diagonally twice.
- 16. Sew a dark triangle to the left side of a medium triangle. Make 12 in each color, except orange, make 16 of those.
- 17. Sew a medium triangle to the left side of a dark triangle. Make 24 in each color, except orange, make 32 of those.

- 18. Cut the remaining 3 %" squares in half diagonally.
- 19. Sew a light color 3 %" triangle to half the step 17 triangles for a 3 ½" unit.

  Make 12 in each color, except for orange, make 16 of those. See left diagram.








20. Sew a lightest color 3 %" triangle to the remaining step 16 and 17 triangles for a 3 ½" unit. Make 24 in each color, except for orange, make 32 of those. See 2 right diagrams above.

21. Arrange 16 units into 4 rows of 4 units each. Sew into rows and sew the rows together for a 12 ½" block
3. Make 3 in each color, except orange, make 4 of those.



Note the smaller dark pinwheel in the center and the larger lightest pinwheel, also the top half and bottom half are the same.









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## **Finishing**

CUT:

Binding

9 @ 2 ½" x wof

- 22. Arrange blocks according to the Quilt Diagram. Sew into rows and sew the rows together.
- 23. Quilt as desired.
- 24. Sew binding strips end to end and bind the quilt.
