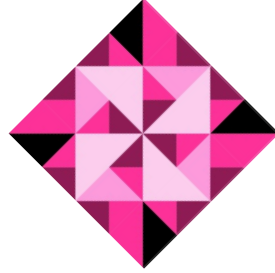

MATERIALS:

Black	3 1/3 yds
White	1/2 yd
Grey	2/3 yd
Dark pink, blue, green & purple	1/4 yd each
Dark orange	1/3 yd
Medium of all 5 colors	1/4 yd each
Light of all 5 colors	1/3 yd each
Lightest of all 5 colors	1/4 yd each
Binding	3/4 yd
Backing	5 yds

Blocks: 6" & 12"

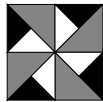

PROJECT NOTES:

- Wof = width of fabric
- Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press as desired.
- Materials and cutting list assumes 42" of usable fabric width.

Block 1



CUT:

Black 3 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
25 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

White 3 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
25 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

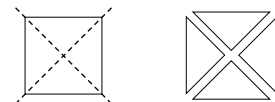
Grey 5 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
50 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

SEW:

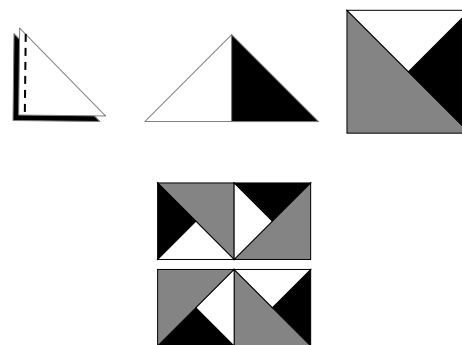
1. Cut the grey squares in half diagonally once.



2. Cut the white and black squares in half diagonally twice.



- Sew each white triangle to the left side of a black triangle. Make 100.
- Sew a grey triangle to each for a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unit.
- Sew 4 units together with the white in the middle creating a pinwheel for a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " block 1. Make 25.

CUT:

Black

- 4 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
16 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 3 @ $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ "

- 1 @ $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
5 @ $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ "

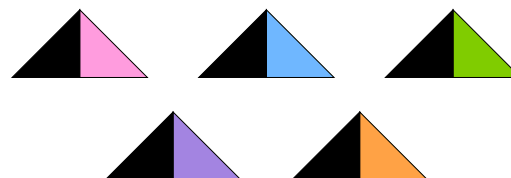
- 14 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof, subcut:
80 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Light pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

- 1 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
3 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ "

- Light Orange** 1 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
4 @ $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ "

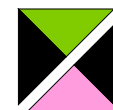
- Cut the black $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares in half diagonally once.
- Cut all the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares in half diagonally twice.
- Sew a color triangle to the right side of a black triangle. Make 12 in each color except for orange, make 16 of those. See diagrams.



- Sew a black $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangle to 3 pink, 4 blue, 4 green, 2 purple and 3 orange pieced triangles for $6\frac{1}{2}$ " units. See below.
- Sew 2 black $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides of the step 9 units. These are the side units. $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "



- Sew the remaining triangles pairs together for $6\frac{1}{2}$ " units. See below for color combinations and amounts.

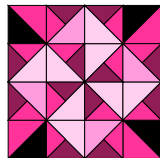

12. Sew 2 black $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " to the black sides of the step 11 units. $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "



Block 3



CUT:

Black

4 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
32 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Dark pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
9 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

Medium pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:
9 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

1 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
6 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Light pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

1 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
6 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Lightest pink, blue, green & purple, from each:

2 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
12 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Dark orange 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:

12 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

Medium orange 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, subcut:

12 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
8 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

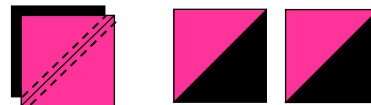
Light orange 1 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
8 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Lightest orange

2 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof, subcut:
16 @ $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

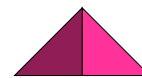
13. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the medium colors $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

14. Pair the medium color and black $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, right sides together, and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line for $3\frac{1}{2}$ " HSTs (half square triangles). Make 12 in each color except orange, make 16 of those.

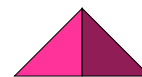


15. Cut the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares in half diagonally twice.

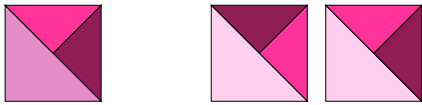
16. Sew a dark triangle to the left side of a medium triangle. Make 12 in each color, except orange, make 16 of those.



17. Sew a medium triangle to the left side of a dark triangle. Make 24 in each color, except orange, make 32 of those.

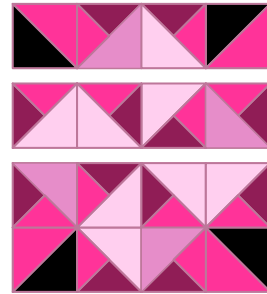


18. Cut the remaining $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares in half diagonally.
19. Sew a light color $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " triangle to half the step 17 triangles for a $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " unit. Make 12 in each color, except for orange, make 16 of those. See left diagram.

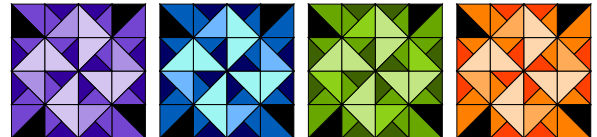


20. Sew a lightest color $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " triangle to the remaining step 16 and 17 triangles for a $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " unit. Make 24 in each color, except for orange, make 32 of those. See 2 right diagrams above.

21. Arrange 16 units into 4 rows of 4 units each. Sew into rows and sew the rows together for a $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " block. Make 3 in each color, except orange, make 4 of those.



Note the smaller dark pinwheel in the center and the larger lightest pinwheel, also the top half and bottom half are the same.



Finishing

CUT:

Binding 9 @ $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

22. Arrange blocks according to the Quilt Diagram. Sew into rows and sew the rows together.
23. Quilt as desired.
24. Sew binding strips end to end and bind the quilt.
