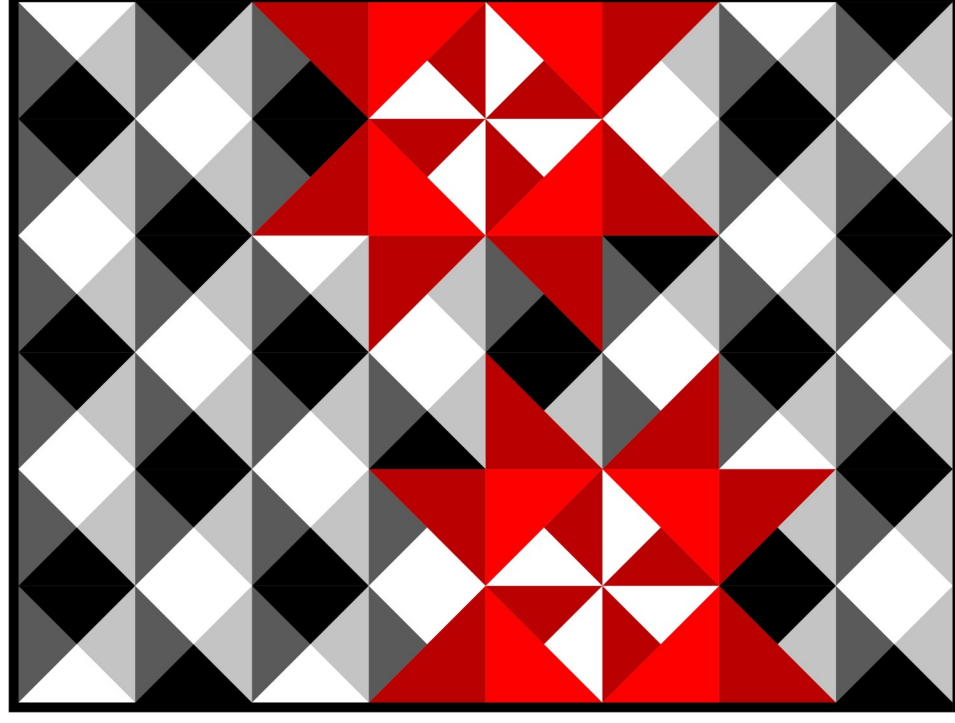

PROJECT NOTES:

- Wof = width of fabric, HST = half square triangle, QST = quarter square triangle
- Use 1/4" seam allowance and press as desired.
- Materials and cutting list assumes 41" of usable fabric width.
- Cutting and sewing instructions are for both large and small quilts with the large measurements always listed first. Example: 13 1/4"/7 1/4"

White 4 @ 13 1/4" x wof, subcut:
11 @ 13 1/4" x 13 1/4"

Dark Grey 3 @ 13 1/4" x wof, subcut:
9 @ 13 1/4" x 13 1/4"

Light Grey 3 @ 13 1/4" x wof, subcut:
9 @ 13 1/4" x 13 1/4"

Black 3 @ 13 1/4" x wof, subcut:
9 @ 13 1/4" x 13 1/4"

Bright Red 2 @ 12 7/8" x wof, subcut:
4 @ 12 7/8" x 12 7/8"

SMALL:

White 3 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut:
11 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"

Dark Grey 2 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut:
9 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"

Light Grey 2 @ 7 1/4" x wof, subcut:
9 @ 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"

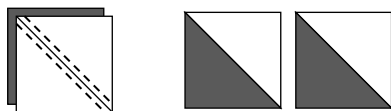

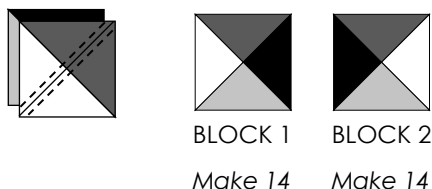
Binding 5 @ 2 1/2" x wof

SEW:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of 7 white 13 1/4"/7 1/4" squares.
2. Pair with dark grey 13 1/4"/7 1/4" squares, right sides together, and sew 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut on the line for 12 7/8"/6 7/8" HSTs (half square triangle). Make 14.



3. Repeat with 7 light grey and black 13 1/4"/7 1/4" squares for 14 light grey/black HSTs.
4. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white/light grey HSTs, making an X with the seam line.
5. Pair a white/dark grey and light grey/black HST, right sides together, as shown below. Sew 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut on the line for a 12 1/2"/6 1/2" QST blocks (quarter square triangles). Make 28.

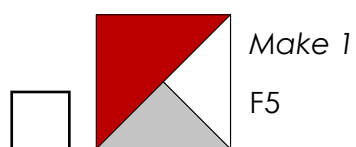
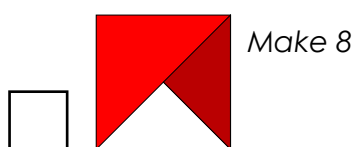
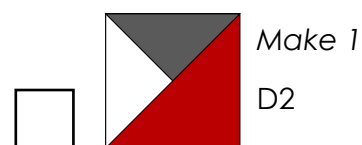
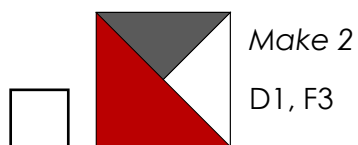
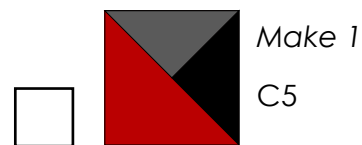
6. Cut the 12 7/8"/6 7/8" squares in half diagonally once.
7. Cut the remaining of the 13 1/4"/7 1/4" squares in half diagonally twice.
8. Following the Block Chart, sew the rest of the blocks together in the amounts indicated. There will be a few triangles left over.



9. Arrange blocks according to the Quilt Diagram and sew together into rows. Letters/numbers such as A1, B3 indicate placement. Sew rows together.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Cut binding strips end to end and bind the quilt.
