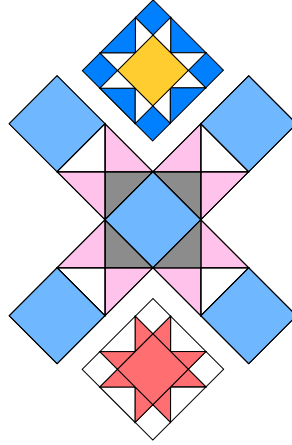

Backing	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd

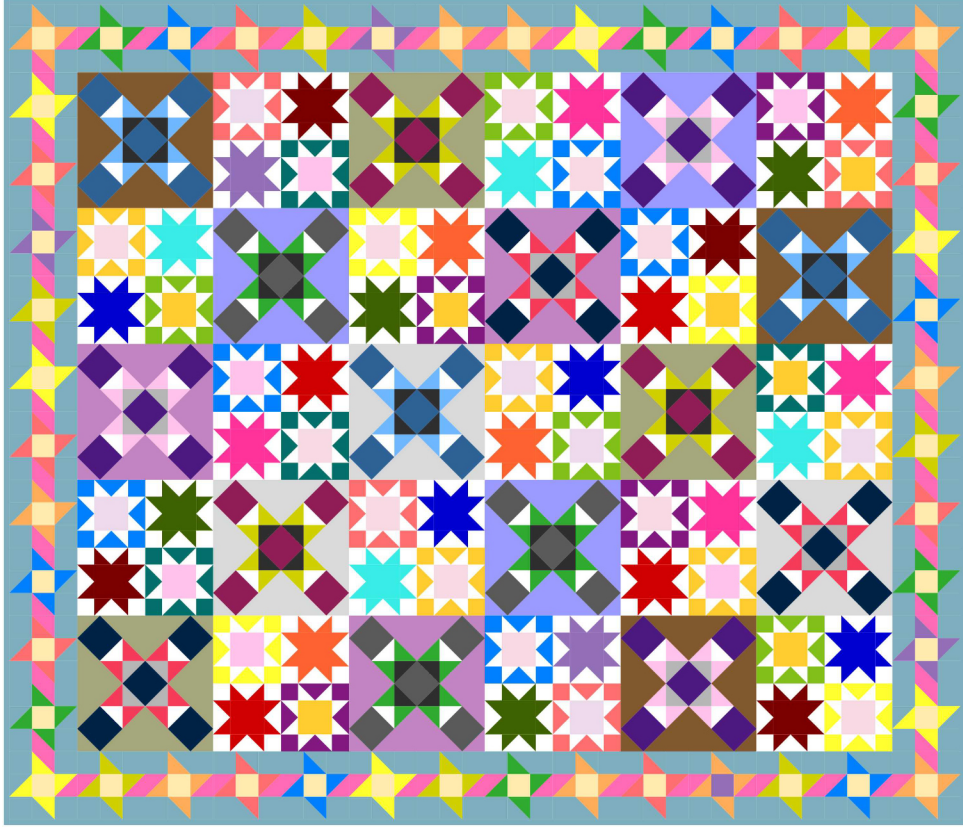

PROJECT NOTES:

- Wof = width of fabric, HST = half square triangle, QST = quarter square triangle
- Use 1/4" seam allowance and press as desired.
- Materials and cutting list assumes 41" of usable fabric width.

Border Star CUT:

Background 4 @ 2 7/8" x wof, subcut:
48 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

12 @ 2 1/2" x wof, subcut:
192 @ 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Pink 4 @ 2 7/8" x wof, subcut:
48 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

4 Fat Quarters, from each:

4 @ 2 7/8" x 22", subcut:
24 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

2 @ 2 1/2" x 22", subcut:
12 @ 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

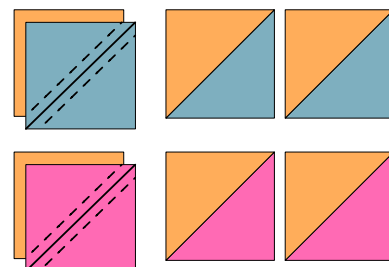
SEW:

1. Divide the fat quarter cuts into 48 piles, with the following in each pile:

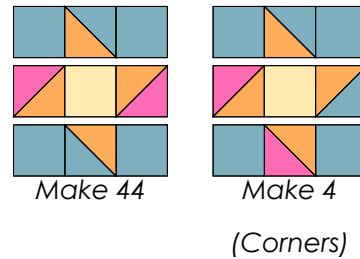
Star points - 2 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

Center - 1 @ 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background and pink 2 7/8" squares.
3. Pair a background and star point 2 7/8" square, right sides together and sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut on the line for 2 1/2" HSTs (half square triangle). Within each pile, make 2 HSTs with background and 2 HSTs with pink.



- Gather one pile and 4 background $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Arrange into 3 rows with the pink and background triangles on the outside.
- Sew into rows and sew the rows together for a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " border star block. Make in the amounts and orientations shown.

119 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "
 - 6 @ 2" x wof, subcut:
120 @ 2" x 2"

- 2 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22", subcut:
9 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
4 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "
- 4 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x 22", subcut:
32 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

1 Fat Quarter:

- 3 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22", subcut:
18 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 2 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x 22", subcut:
12 @ $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

1 Fat Quarter:

- 3 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22", subcut:
15 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

3 Fat Quarters, from each:

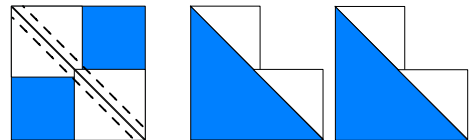
- 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 22", subcut:
8 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 4 @ 2" x 22", subcut:
32 @ 2" x 2"

1 Fat Quarter:

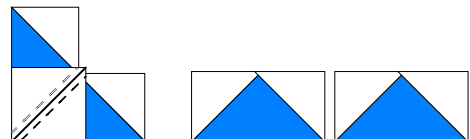
- 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 22", subcut:
6 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 3 @ 2" x 22", subcut:
24 @ 2" x 2"

SEW:

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white and fat quarter $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
- Lay two $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares on opposite corners of a $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square, right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line and cut on the line. Fold the triangles back. *Half will have white $2\frac{3}{8}$ " with color $4\frac{1}{4}$ " while the other half will have color $2\frac{3}{8}$ " with white $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".*



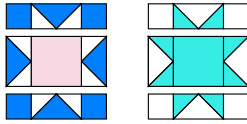
- Lay another $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square on the corner, right sides together, and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line for two 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " flying geese. Make 240.



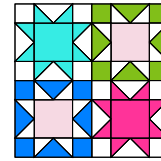
- Gather 4 same flying geese, 4 same color 2" squares and a color $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. *Half will have a color background with a different color*

center while the other half will have a white background and single color star (points and center the same color).

10. Sew into 3 rows and sew the rows together for a 6 1/2" star. Make 60.



11. Sew 2 stars with a white background and 2 with a color background together with the white backgrounds on opposite diagonal corners for a 12 1/2" 4 star block. Make 15.



X Star CUT:

White 3 @ 2 7/8" x wof, subcut:
30 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

2 Fat Quarters, from each:

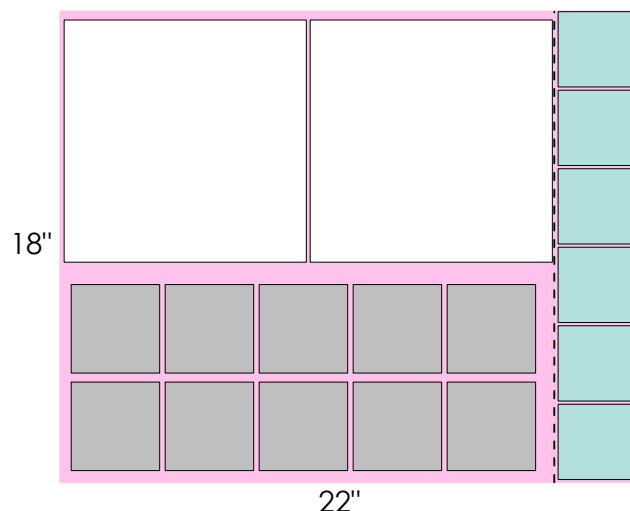
5 @ 2 7/8" x 22", subcut:
35 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

7 Fat Quarters, from each:

First cut: 1 @ 2 7/8" x 18", subcut:
6 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"
See black dashed line below.

Second cut: 1 @ 9 1/4" x 19", subcut:
2 @ 9 1/4" x 9 1/4"

Third cuts: 2 @ 3 3/8" x 19", subcut:
10 @ 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"



1 Fat Quarter 1 @ 9 1/4" x 22", subcut:
1 @ 9 1/4" x 9 1/4"
9 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

1 @ 3 3/8" x 22", subcut:
5 @ 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"

1 @ 2 7/8" x 22", subcut:
7 @ 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

SEW:

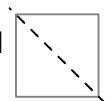
12. Divide the cuts into 15 piles, with the following in each pile:

1 st color	1 @ 9 1/4"
	2 @ 2 7/8"
2 nd color	5 @ 3 3/8"
3 rd color	4 @ 2 7/8"
4 th color	2 @ 2 7/8"
White	2 @ 2 7/8"

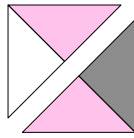
Note: There will be extra 2 7/8" squares.

13. Work one pile at a time.

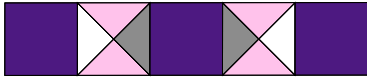
14. Cut the 3rd color, 4th color and white 2 7/8" squares in half diagonally once.



15. Sew two 3rd color, one 4th color and a white triangle together as shown for a 3 ³/₈" QST (quarter square triangle). Make 4.

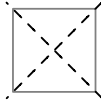


16. Sew three 2nd color squares and 2 QSTs together in a row. Note the white sides touch the end squares.

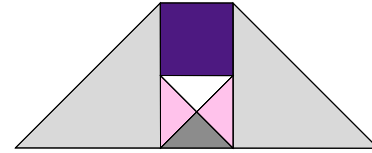


17. Sew a 2nd color square to the white side of a QST. Make 2. See step 19 diagram.

18. Cut the 9 ¹/₄" square in half diagonally twice.

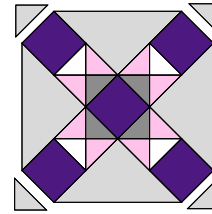


19. Sew 2 triangles on either side of step 17. Make 2.



20. Sew the step 16 between the 2 step 19.

21. Cut the 1st color 2 ⁷/₈" squares in half diagonally once and sew to the corners for a 12 ¹/₂" X star block. Make 15.



Finishing CUT:

Binding 8 @ 2 ¹/₂" x wof

SEW:

22. Arrange the blocks into 6 rows of 5 blocks each, alternating the different 12 ¹/₂" blocks.
23. Sew into rows and sew the rows together.
24. Sew 12 border stars together on the pink sides for a side border. Make 2 and sew to the quilt sides.
25. Sew 10 border stars together on the pink sides with a corner border star on the ends for a top border. See the Quilt Diagram for the corner orientation.
26. Repeat step 25 for a bottom border.
27. Sew on the top and bottom borders.
28. Quilt as desired.
29. Sew the binding strips end to end and bind the quilt.
